

# Scriptures and Prayers Involving Deliverance.

## Trust the Lord

### **2 Corinthians 1: 8-10**

We do not want you to be uninformed, brothers, about the hardships we suffered in the province of Asia. We were under great pressure, far beyond our ability to endure, so that we despaired even of life. Indeed, in our hearts we felt the sentence of death. But this happened that we might not rely on ourselves but on God, who raises the dead. He has delivered us from such a deadly peril, and He will deliver us. On Him we have set our hope that He will continue to deliver us.

### **Nahum 1: 7**

The Lord is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust him.

### **Isaiah 50: 10**

Who among you fears the Lord and obeys the word of his servant? Let him who walks in the dark, who has no light, trust in the name of the Lord and rely on his God.

### **Psalms 18: 1-3**

For the director of music. Of David the servant of the Lord. he sang to the Lord the words of this song when the Lord delivered him from the hand of all his enemies and from the hand of Saul. He said: "I love you, O Lord, my strength. The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer; my God is my rock, in whom I take refuge. he is my shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold. I call to the Lord, who is worthy of praise, and I am saved from my enemies."

### **Psalms 37: 40**

The Lord helps them and delivers them; He delivers them from the wicked and saves them, because they take refuge in Him.

### **Jeremiah 39: 18**

I will save you; you will not fall by the sword but will escape with your life, because you trust in me, declares the Lord.

### **Isaiah 12: 2**

Surely God is my salvation; I will trust and not be afraid. The Lord, the Lord, is my strength and my song; He has become my salvation.

### **Psalms 34: 22**

The Lord redeems His servants; no one will be condemned who takes refuge in Him.

### **Psalms 25: 2**

In you I trust, O my God. Do not let me be put to shame, nor let my enemies triumph over me.

### **2 Samuel 22: 3**

My God is my rock, in whom I take refuge, my shield and the horn of my salvation. He is my stronghold, my refuge and my savior – from violent men you save me.

### **Psalms 91: 9-11**

If you make the Most High your dwelling – even the Lord, who is my refuge – then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent. For He will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways.

**Psalm 27: 5-6**

For in the day of trouble He will keep me safe in His dwelling; He will hide me in the shelter of His tabernacle and set me high upon a rock. Then my head will be exalted above the enemies who surround me; at His tabernacle will I sacrifice with shouts of joy; I will sing and make music to the Lord.

4) He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart.

**Psalm 46: 10**

Be still and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations. I will be exalted in the earth.

**Psalm 107: 28-30**

Then they cried out to the Lord in their trouble, and He brought them out of their distress. He stilled the storm to a whisper; the waves of the sea were hushed. They were glad when it grew calm, and He guided them to their desired haven.

## Verses on Angelic Involvement in Deliverance

**John: 12: 47-48**

As for the person who hears my words but does not keep them. I do not judge him. For I did not come to judge the world, but to save it. There is a judge for the one who rejects me and does not accept my words; that very word which I spoke will condemn him at the last day.

30) For we know him who said, "It is mine to avenge; I will repay," and again, "The Lord will judge his people." 23) to the church of the firstborn, whose names are written in heaven. You have come to God, the judge of all men, to the spirits of righteous men made perfect,

**Acts 17: 31**

For he has set a day when he will judge the world with justice by the name he has appointed. He has given proof of this to all men by raising him from the dead.

**2 Timothy 4: 8**

Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day - and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing.

**1 Peter 2: 23**

When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate; when he suffered, he made no threats. Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly.

**John 16: 7-11**

But I tell you the truth: It is for your good that I am going away. Unless I go away, the Counselor will not come to you; but if I go, I will send him to you. When he comes, he will convict the world of guilt in regard to sin and righteousness and judgment: in regard to sin because men do not believe in me; in regard to righteousness, because I am going to the Father, where you can see me no longer; and in regard to judgment, because the prince of this world now stands condemned.

**Revelation 19: 11**

I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and makes war.

## **Destruction of Demons**

**Mark: 1: 24**

“What do you want with us. Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are - the Holy One of God!”

**Luke 4:34**

“Ha! What do you want with us. Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are - the Holy One of God!”

**1 Corinthians 2: 6, 8**

6) We do, however, speak a message of wisdom among the mature, but not the wisdom of this age or of the rulers of this age, who are coming to nothing. 8) None of the rulers of this age understood it, for if they had, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.

**Isaiah 27: 1**

In that day, the Lord will punish with his sword, his fierce, great and powerful sword, Leviathan the gliding serpent, Leviathan the coiling serpent; he will slay the monster of the sea.

**Deuteronomy 9: 3**

but be assured today that the Lord your God is the one who goes across ahead of you like a devouring fire. He will destroy them; he will subdue them before you. And you will drive them out and annihilate them quickly, as the Lord has promised you.

**Psalm 82 (A psalm of Asaph.)**

God presides in the great assembly; he gives judgment among the “gods”: How long will you defend the unjust and show partiality to the wicked: (selah) Defend the cause of the weak and fatherless; maintain the rights of the poor and oppressed. Rescue the weak and needy: deliver them from the hand of the wicked. They know nothing, they understand nothing. They walk about in darkness; all the foundations of the earth

are shaken/I said, 'You are "gods"; you are all sons of the Most High.' But you will die like mere men; you will fall like every other ruler. Rise up, O God, judge the earth, for all the nations are your inheritance.

### **Revelation 19: 20**

But the beast was captured, and with him the false prophet who had performed the miraculous signs on his behalf. With these signs he had deluded those who had received the mark of the beast and worshiped his image. The two of them were thrown alive into the fiery lake of burning sulfur.

### **Revelation 20: 10**

And the devil, who deceived them, was thrown into the lake of burning sulfur, where the beast and the false prophet had been thrown. They will be tormented day and night for ever and ever.

### **Revelation 14**

then I looked, and there before me was the Lamb, standing on Mount Zion, and with him 144,000 who had his name and his Father's name written on their foreheads. And I heard a sound from heaven like the roar of rushing waters and like a loud peal of thunder. the sound I heard was like that of harpists playing their harps. And they sang a new song before the throne and before the four living creatures and the elders. No one could learn the song except the 144,000 who had been redeemed from the earth. These are those who did not defile themselves with women, for they kept themselves pure. They follow the Lamb wherever he goes. They were purchased from among men and offered as firstfruits to God and the Lamb. No lie was found in their mouths; they are blameless. Then I saw another angel flying in midair, and he had the eternal gospel to proclaim to those who live on the earth—to every nation, tribe, language and people. He said in a loud voice, "Fear God and give him glory, because the hour of his judgment has come. Worship him who made the heavens, the earth, the sea and the springs of water." A second angel followed and said, "Fallen! Fallen is Babylon the Great, which made all the nations drink the maddening wine of her adulteries." A third angel followed them and said in a loud voice: "If anyone worships the beast and his image and receives his mark on the forehead or on the hand, he, too, will drink of the wine of God's fury, which has been poured full strength into the cup of his wrath. He will be tormented with burning sulfur in the presence of the holy angels and of the Lamb. And the smoke of their torment rises for ever and ever. There is no rest day or night for those who worship the beast and his image, or for anyone who receives the mark of his name." This calls for patient endurance on the part of the saints who obey God's commandments and remain faithful to Jesus. Then I heard a voice from heaven say, "Write: Blessed are the dead who die in the Lord from now on." "Yes." says the Spirit. "They will rest from their labor, for their deeds will follow them." I looked, and there before me was a white cloud, and seated on the cloud was one: like a son of man: with a crown of gold on his head and a sharp sickle in his hand. Then another angel came out of the temple and called in a loud voice to him who was sitting on the cloud, "Take your sickle and reap, because the time to reap has come, for the harvest for the earth is ripe." So he who was seated on the cloud swung his sickle over the earth, and the earth was harvested. Another angel came out of the temple in heaven, and he too had a sharp sickle. Still another angel, who had charge of the fire, came from the altar and called in a loud voice to him who had the sharp sickle, "Take your sharp sickle and gather the clusters of grapes from the earth's vine, because its grapes are ripe." The angel swung his sickle on the earth, gathered its grapes and threw them into the great winepress of God's wrath. They were trampled in the winepress outside the city, and blood flowed out of the press, rising as high as the horses' bridles for a distance of 1,600 stadia. *(or about 180 miles.)*

## **God's Judgments through His saints**

### **1 Corinthians: 6: 2-3**

Do you not know that the saints will judge the world? And if you are to judge the world, are you not competent to judge trivial cases? Do you not know that we will judge angels? How much more the things of this life!

**Acts 5: 5-9**

When Ananias heard this, he fell down and died, And great fear seized all who heard what had happened. Then the young men came forward, wrapped up his body, and carried him out and buried him. About three hours later his wife came in, not knowing what had happened. Peter asked her, "Tell me, is this the price you and Ananias got for the land?" "Yes," she said, "that is the price." Peter said to her, "How could you agree to test the Spirit of the Lord? Look! The feet of the men who buried your husband are at the door, and they will carry you out also."

**2 Chronicles 19: 5-7**

He appointed judges in the land, in each of the fortified cities of Judah. He told them, "Consider carefully what you do, because you are not judging for man but for the Lord, who is with you whenever you give a verdict. Not let the fear of the Lord be upon you. Judge carefully for with the Lord our God there is no injustice or partiality or bribery."

**Psalm 149: 5-9**

Let the saints rejoice in this honor and sing for joy on their beds. May the praise of God be in their mouths and a double-edged sword in their hands, to inflict vengeance on the nations and punishment on the peoples, to bind their kings with fetters, their nobles with shackles of iron, to carry out the sentence written against them. **Isaiah 49: 1-4**

Listen to me, you islands; hear this, you distant nations: Before I was born the Lord called me; from my birth he has made mention of my name. He made my mouth like a sharpened sword, in the shadow of his hand he hid me; he made me into a polished arrow and concealed me in his quiver. He said to me, "You are my servant, Israel, in whom I will display my splendor." But I said, "I have labored to no purpose; I have spent my strength in vain and for nothing, Yet what is due me is in the Lord's hand. and my reward is with my God."

## **Angels working in warfare**

**Matthew 13: 49-50**

This is how it will be at the end of the age. The angels will come and separate the wicked from the righteous and throw them into the fiery furnace, where there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.

**Hebrews 1: 7, 14**

7) In speaking of the angels he says, "He makes his angels winds, his servants flames of fire."  
14) Are not all angels ministering spirits sent to serve those who will inherit salvation?

**Matthew 26: 53**

Do you think I cannot call on my Father, and he will at once put at my disposal more than twelve legions of angels?

**Psalm 103: 20**

Praise the Lord, you his angels, you mighty ones who do his bidding, who obey his word.

**Revelation 12: 7-10**

And there was war in heaven. Michael and his angels fought against the dragon, and the dragon and his angels fought back. But he was not strong enough, and they lost their place in heaven. The great dragon was hurled down—that ancient serpent called the devil, or Satan, who leads the whole world astray. He was hurled to the earth, and his angels with him. Then I heard a loud voice in heaven say: "Now have come the salvation and the power and the kingdom of our God, and the authority of his Christ. For the accuser of our brothers, who accuses them before our God day and night, has been hurled down.

I lift my hand to heaven and declare: As surely as I live forever, when I sharpen my flashing sword and my hand grasps it in judgment, I will take vengeance on my adversaries and repay those who hate me. I will make my arrows drunk with blood, whole my sword devours flesh: the blood of the slain and the captives, the heads of the enemy leaders.”

and say to her: ‘This is what the Lord says: I am against you. I will draw my sword from its scabbard and cut off from you both the righteous and the wicked. Because I am going to cut off the righteous and the wicked, my sword will be unsheathed against everyone from south to north. Then all people will know that I the Lord have drawn my sword from its scabbard: it will not return again.’ “Therefore groan, son of man! Groan before them with broken heart and bitter grief. And when they ask you, ‘Why are you groaning?’ you shall say, ‘Because of the news that is coming. Every heart will melt and every hand go limp; every spirit will become faint and every knee become as weak as water.’ It is coming! It will surely take place, declares the Sovereign Lord.” The word of the Lord came to me: “son of man, prophesy and say, ‘This is what the Lord says: “A sword, a sword, sharpened and polished—sharpened for the slaughter, polished to flash like lightning! “Shall we rejoice in the scepter of my son (Judah)? The sword despises every such stick. “The sword is appointed to be polished, to be grasped with the hand; it is sharpened and polished, made ready for the hand of the slayer. Cry out and wail, son of man, for it is against my people; it is against all the princes of Israel. They are thrown to the sword along with my people. Therefore beat your breast. ““Testing will surely come. And what is the scepter (of Judah), which the sword despises, does not continue? declares the Sovereign Lord.’ “So then, son of man, prophesy and strike your hands together. Let the sword strike twice, even three times. It is a sword for slaughter—a sword for great slaughter, closing in on them from every side. So that hearts may melt and the fallen be many. I have stationed the sword for slaughter at all their gates. Oh! It is made to flash like lightning, it is grasped for slaughter. O sword, slash to the right, then to the left, wherever your blade is turned.

**Jeremiah 25: 31**

The tumult will resound to the ends of the earth, for the Lord will bring charges against the nations; he will bring judgment on all mankind and put the wicked to the sword.” Declares the Lord.

**Leviticus 26: 7-8**

You will pursue your enemies, and they will fall by the sword before you. Five of you will chase a hundred, and a hundred of you will chase ten thousand, and your enemies will fall by the sword before you.

## Using fire of God and Holy Spirit

**Genesis 19: 24**

Then the Lord rained down burning sulfur on Sodom and Gomorrah—from the Lord out of the heavens.

**2 Kings 1: 11-12**

At this the king sent to Elijah another captain with his fifty men. The captain said to him, “Man of God, this is what the king says, ‘Come down at once!’” “If I am a man of God,” Elijah replied, “may fire come down from heaven and consume you and your fifty men!” Then the fire of God fell from heaven and consumed him and his fifty men.

**Job 1: 16**

While he was still speaking, another messenger came and said, “The fire of God fell from the sky and burned up the sheep and the servants, and I am the only one who has escaped to tell you!”

**Psalm 97: 1-6**

The Lord reigns, let the earth be glad; let the distant shores rejoice. Clouds and thick darkness surround him; righteousness and justice are the foundations of his throne, Fire goes before him and consumes his foes on every side. His lightning lights up the world; the earth sees and trembles. The mountains melt like wax before the Lord. Before the Lord of all the earth. The heavens proclaim his righteousness, and all the peoples see his glory.

**Psalm 50: 3-4**

Our God comes and will not be silent; a fire devours before him, and around him a tempest rages. He summons the heavens above, and the earth, that he may judge his people.

**Joel 2: 29-30**

Even on my servants, both men and women, I will pour out my spirit in those days. I will show wonders in the heavens and on the earth, blood and fire and billows of smoke.

**Malachi 4: 1**

“Surely the day is coming; it will burn like a furnace. All the arrogant and every evildoer will be stubble, and that day that is coming will set them on fire.” says the Lord Almighty. “Not a root or a branch will be left to them.

**Isaiah 29: 6**

the Lord almighty will come with thunder and earthquake and great noise, with windstorm and tempest and flames of a devouring fire.

**Matt 3:11**

"I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not fit to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and with fire.

**Luke 12: 49**

"I have come to bring fire on the earth, and how I wish it were already kindled!

**Acts 2: 19**

I will show wonders in the heaven above and signs on the earth below, blood and fire and billows of smoke.

**2 Thessalonians 1: 6-10**

God is just: He will pay back trouble to those who trouble you and give relief to you who are troubled, and to us as well. This will happen when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven in blazing fire with his powerful angels. He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the majesty of his power on the day he comes to be glorified in his holy people and to be marveled at among all those who have believed. This includes you, because you believed our testimony to you.

**Deuteronomy 9: 3**

But be assured today that the LORD your God is the one who goes across ahead of you like a devouring fire. He will destroy them; he will subdue them before you. And you will drive them out and annihilate them quickly, as the LORD has promised you.

**Hebrews 12: 28**

Therefore, since we are receiving a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us be thankful, and so worship God acceptably with reverence and awe.

**Zechariah 2: 5**

And I myself will be a wall of fire around it,' declares the LORD, and I will be its glory within.'

**Psalm 18: 37-42**

I pursued my enemies and overtook them; I did not turn back till they were destroyed. I crushed them so that they could not rise; they fell beneath my feet. You armed me with strength for battle; you made my adversaries bow at my feet. You made my enemies turn their backs in flight, and I destroyed my foes. They cried for help, but there was no one to save them—to the LORD, but he did not answer. I beat them as fine as dust borne on the wind; I poured them out like mud in the streets.

## **To speak out loud in times of warfare**

**Psalm 51 (repentance)**

For the director of music. A psalm of David. When the prophet Nathan came to him after David had committed adultery with Bathsheba. 1) Have mercy on me, O God, according to your unfailing love; according to your great compassion blot out my transgressions. 2) Wash away all my iniquity and cleanse me from my sin. 3) For I know my transgressions, and my sin is always before me. 4) Against you, you only, have I sinned and done what is evil in your sight, so that you are proved right when you speak and justified when you judge. 5) Surely I was sinful at birth, sinful from the time my mother conceived me. 6) Surely you desire truth in the inner parts ; you teach me wisdom in the inmost place. 7) Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow. 8) Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones you have crushed rejoice. 9) Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity. 10) Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me. 11) Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me. 12) Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me. 13) Then I will teach transgressors your ways, and sinners will turn back to you. 14) Save me from bloodguilt, O God, the God who saves me, and my tongue will sing of your righteousness. 15) O Lord, open my lips, and my mouth will declare your praise. 16) You do not delight in sacrifice, or I would bring it; you do not take pleasure in burnt offerings. 17) The sacrifices of God are a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart, O God, you will not despise. 18) In your good pleasure make Zion prosper; build up the walls of Jerusalem. 19) Then there will be righteous sacrifices, whole burnt offerings to delight you; then bulls will be offered on your altar.

**Psalm 35: 4-9**

4) May those who seek my life be disgraced and put to shame; may those who plot my ruin be turned back in dismay. 5) May they be like chaff before the wind, with the angel of the Lord driving them away; 6) may their path be dark and slippery, with the angel of the Lord pursuing them. 7) Since they hid their net for me without cause and without cause dug a pit for me, 8) may ruin overtake them by surprise- may the net they hid entangle them, may they fall into the pit, to their ruin. 9) Then my soul will rejoice in the Lord and delight in his salvation.

**Psalm 35: 11-14 & 18**

11) Ruthless witnesses come forward; they question me on things I know nothing about. 12) They repay me evil for good and leave my soul forlorn. 13) Yet when they were ill, I put on sackcloth and humbled myself with fasting. When my prayers returned to me unanswered, 14) I went about mourning as though for my friend or brother. I bowed my head in grief as though weeping for my mother. 18) I will give you thanks in the great assembly; among throngs of people I will praise you.

**Micah 7: 8-10**

8) Do not gloat over me, my enemy! Though I have fallen, I will rise. Though I sit in darkness, the Lord will be my light. 9) Because I have sinned against him, I will bear the Lord 's wrath, until he pleads my case and establishes my right. He will bring me out into the light; I will see his righteousness. 10) Then my enemy will see it and will be covered with shame, she who said to me, "Where is the Lord your God?" My eyes will see her downfall; even now she will be trampled underfoot like mire in the streets.

**Psalm 91**

1) He who dwells in the shelter of the Most High will rest in the shadow of the Almighty. 2) I will say of the LORD , "He is my refuge and my fortress, my God, in whom I trust." 3) Surely he will save you from the fowler's snare and from the deadly pestilence. 4) He will cover you with his feathers, and under his wings you will find refuge; his faithfulness will be your shield and rampart. 5) You will not fear the terror of night, nor the arrow that flies by day, 6) nor the pestilence that stalks in the darkness, nor the plague that destroys at midday. 7) A thousand may fall at your side, ten thousand at your right hand, but it will not come near you. 8) You will only observe with your eyes and see the punishment of the wicked. 9) If you make the Most High your dwelling - even the LORD , who is my refuge - 10) then no harm will befall you, no disaster will come near your tent. 11) For he will command his angels concerning you to guard you in all your ways; 12) they will lift you up in their hands, so that you will not strike your foot against a stone. 13) You will tread upon the lion and the cobra; you will trample the great lion and the serpent. 14) "Because he loves me," says the LORD , "I will rescue him; I will protect him, for he acknowledges my name. 15) He will call upon me, and I will answer him; I will be with him in trouble, I will deliver him and honor him. 16) With long life will I satisfy him and show him my salvation."

## **To speak out loud Every Morning:**

Lord I ask you to come to me and fill me up with your Holy Spirit. Forgive me of my sins, seen and unseen. Fill me and seal me in the Holy Blood of the LJCONWCITF. Lord, I ask that your angels would come - sever and remove all territorial ties, contracts and assignments, curses and spells, originals, backups and replacements - and send them all to the abyss. And Lord, I ask that your angels would sever and remove all false prayers coming against me from any person, witch and coven. I ask they would be sent back to that person or persons and let the fire from the Holy Spirit burn them up in their camps to speak truth and light - to the glory of the LJCONWCITF.

Lord, I ask that if any human spirits are caught in-between the canopy and or diamond hedge, that your angels would escort them out and put them in a place where the Holy Spirit can minister truth to them. I ask you to burn up all false Jesus or Holy Spirit that may be trying to speak to me.

Put on full armor of God (Ephesians 6) out loud. I ask you to put the breastplate of righteousness and the belt of truth in its right place. I ask that my feet be placed in the gospel of your peace. Let me carry the sword of the Spirit, high and mighty, which is your word. Surround me with the shield of faith that would extinguish all arrows of the enemy. I put the helmet of salvation securely upon my head. Surround me with your light and fire that would lead me and follow me wherever I go. Let your glory be at my back door. Cloak me in your glory today. Let it penetrate every part of me. Hide me in your light. Take me deep within your wings. And let me not be found by the eyes of the enemy.

I put myself on the altar of sacrifice, in front of your throne. Along with any wood, hay or stubble. And I ask you to burn away everything that does not belong to you. Also Lord, close the door to my imagination so that my mind would not get attacked. I seal this prayer in the Blood, Power and Authority of the Lord JCONWCITF by the blood, cross and resurrection.

It belongs to You.

## **General prayer to speak out loud when under attack**

Lord I ask you to come to this (lie of...doubt, depression, spirit behind the fear - whatever is attacking you) and send your warring angels to Bind, Sever and remove it, along with all cadre behind it and all cadre behind that. And I ask that they would be taken to the abyss right now in the Name and with the blood of the LJCONWCITF! To the Glory of Jesus!

## Various Warfare Prayers

“With the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth who came in the flesh, I sever, remove and send to the Abyss all originals, backups, replacements and the power of the double portion of all curses, spells, and ties which have been used to afflict (person’s name).”

“Father, in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth who came in the flesh, I draw a line in the sand between myself and all enemies of the Kingdom of God, fill it with the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ, purify it with the fire of the Holy Spirit and station Your angels upon that line to protect myself and my family.”




I ask the Holy Spirit to burn with His fire every demonic spirit responsible for executing these assignments in all time, space and dimensions in the Universe.”

“Father, I declare that everything you show me that I now describe will be destroyed by the fire and brimstone of the Most High God, the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth who came in the flesh, or the fire of the Holy Spirit. I ask you to show me everything in all time, space and dimensions in the Universe, including those things visible and invisible to the spiritual eye.” (After naming all things heard or seen in the Spirit say), “I ask the Holy Spirit to burn with His fire every demonic spirit responsible for executing these devices in all time, space and dimensions in the Universe.”

“Father, let all spirits of human beings involved with (person’s name) that are currently being used by any principality, power, ruler of darkness, coven or council member, or any other power of the darkness in all time, space and dimensions in the Universe, be brought to the throne of God. Let those whose names are not written in the Lamb’s Book of Life be judged immediately according to the will of the Son of the Most High God.

Let those whose names are written in the Lamb’s Book of Life be cleansed of their demonic powers by removing all devices, curses and occult powers with the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ of Nazareth who came in the flesh.
